- Appellate jurisdiction from district courts

General District Court

(Judge/no jury)

- Original jurisdiction of misdemeanors
 - Civil cases less than \$1000

Juvenile and Domestic Relations District Court

(Judge/no jury)

• Juvenile and family cases

Magistrates issue search warrants, subpoenas, arrest warrants, and summons and set bail.
